### COMPLETE YOUR DEGREE IN A YEAR

Take university courses in your community for one year and earn your bachelor's degree without relocating.

Each course is delivered in a hybrid format with in-person and online instruction, so you'll experience face-to-face faculty and peer connection with the convenience of materials and instruction available via the Web.

What to expect during your year as an NAU student:

- **Class days and times:** Two evenings per week (usually Mondays and Wednesdays, or Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 6 to 8 p.m.)
- **Location:** Pima Community College–Downtown Campus
- **Course delivery:** Hybrid format with each course incorporating in-person and online instruction
- **Fall semester:** Two eight-week sessions, enrolling in two courses at a time
- **Spring semester:** Two eight-week sessions, enrolling in two courses at a time
- **Summer session:** One eight-week session, enrolling in two courses
